

A HONORING EXTRAORDINARY COMPASSION: 2025 WHITE HORSE AWARD WINNERS

This year's honorees—Chino Gudino, Luis Gudino, and Doug Adams of Mountaineer Racetrack—remind us that heroism isn't always dramatic; sometimes, it's found in quiet moments of care and love that reflect the heart of the horse racing family.

The White Horse Award honors unsung heroes in the racing community—individuals whose courage and compassion uplift others. Since its inception in 2003, this tradition has celebrated acts of bravery and selflessness, whether lifesaving or deeply transformative.

A STORY OF FRIENDSHIP AND SACRIFICE

The trio's journey began with a promise to a dear friend, Dennis VanMeter, a Vietnam veteran and longtime horseman at Mountaineer. When Dennis was diagnosed with terminal cancer, Chino, Luis, and Doug stepped in—not out of obligation, but out of love. They transformed his tack room into a peaceful sanctuary, ensuring Dennis spent his final days surrounded by dignity and care. They tended his horses, managed his barn, and fulfilled his wishes, offering companionship and comfort until his passing in September 2024.

Their devotion went far beyond daily chores; it was a testament to the profound spirit of family within racing—a community that rallies together in life's most difficult moments. Their actions exemplify the best core values of the racing community—love, respect, and steadfast support.

The Race Track Chaplaincy of America (RTCA) proudly recognized Mindy Coleman as the recipient of the 2025 Community Service Award during its annual Night of Faith, Hope, and Love at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on October 28, held during Breeders' Cup World Championships week. This award celebrates individuals whose generosity and commitment have profoundly impacted racetrack chaplaincy ministries and the broader horse racing community.





Mindy Coleman is widely respected for her role as counsel for the Jockeys' Guild, where she has long championed the rights and well-being of jockeys nationwide. Her influence, however, extends far beyond her professional responsibilities. As a National Ambassador for Race Track Chaplaincy of America, Mindy actively promotes its mission and devotes her time to initiatives that embody care and compassion within the racing industry. She volunteers with the Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund (PDJF), Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation (TRF), and Thoroughbred Charities of America (TCA). Since 2021, she has also served on the selection committee for the Thoroughbred Industry Employee Awards (TIEA), presented by Godolphin, ensuring that the contributions of behindthe-scenes workers receive the recognition they deserve.

Her dedication extends into her local community as well, where she serves on the boards of Miss Rodeo Kentucky and the Lexington Children's Theatre—reflecting a life committed to service and leadership. Those who know Mindy describe her as someone who leads with humility and a servant's heart—qualities that make her impact both profound and lasting.


