CHAPLAIN MICHAEL BINGAMAN CONTINUES TO GROW RACE TRACK MINISTRY IN SOUTH TEXAS

Years of patience, prayers, and hard work have been poured into the ministry at Retama Park Race Track. In July, the Chaplaincy held a ceremony to celebrate a blessing many years in the making- a chapel.

The Chapel at Retama Park racetrack in Selma, Texas, is a meaningful addition to that racing community. It will serve as a spiritual refuge for those working there. Spearheaded by RTCA Chaplain Michael Bingaman, the chapel was built to provide a dedicated space for worship, study, educational classes and fellowship right on the grounds of the racetrack.

The chapel's location is central to a lot of activity and it's impact will be far reaching. It now hosts regular services, Bible studies, and one-on-one support for jockeys, trainers, grooms, and other racetrack staff. Chaplain Bingaman's ministry has been praised for its compassion and accessibility, especially for those facing unique challenges at the track.

This summer marks the retirement of Chaplain Sam Ed Spence after a long and impactful career in race track ministry. Since the opening of Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas in 1997, Chaplain Sam Ed has faithfully served the horse racing community with unwavering dedication.

Over more than two decades, Sam worked alongside key organizations including the American Quarter Horse Association, the American Paint Horse Association, and the Quarter Horse Racing Owners of America—building connections that reflected both his passion for ministry and love for the industry.

His leadership journey began in 1981 when he became the first full-time Executive Director of Race Track Chaplaincy of America (RTCA), following his service as an interim pastor. Though he stepped away from RTCA in 1986 to return to full-time pastoring, he was called back to the racetrack ministry in 1995, serving at Trinity Meadows Raceway in Willow Park, and eventually returning to Lone Star Park.

In 2006, Chaplain Sam Ed penned Daily Oats, a devotional created to nourish the souls of those working in the horse racing world. More than just a book, it became a lifeline of encouragement and Scripture in a high-paced, high-pressure industry. Through its pages, readers found daily reminders of God's presence in their work, their struggles, and their victories. The Race Track Chaplaincy of America has shared Daily Oats with hundreds upon hundreds of individuals—each copy a seed of hope, each word a gentle nudge toward grace. Chaplain Sam Ed's calling wasn't just to preach—it was to walk alongside others, guiding them toward the heart of Christ through both word and witness.

Chaplain Sam Ed's life is a shining example of how one person, led by faith and fueled by love for others, can touch countless lives. His work continues to ripple outward, inspiring new generations in the race track community and beyond.
